



Sudden Value Shift – Flat Sided Forms

(Flat forms always have two very different values touching. One value per one side.)



1. On the reverse side, label the form face with a value.
2. Shade the dark side first.
3. Outline parallel to the edges.
4. Then fill. Turn your paper when needed.
 - Use little parallel marks between the dotted lines.
 - Shade in the direction of the arrows.
 - Make each pencil stop on the dotted lines.
 - Overlap each section of shading with the previous one.
5. Shade the light side second.
6. Shade the medium side third.



Gradual Value Shift – Rounded Form

(Rounded forms are always darker on the edge and light in the middle.)



- Use little parallel marks between the dotted lines.
 - Shade in the direction of the arrows.
1. Fill first.
 2. Start with the dark and gradually lighten the pressure until the lightest point in the middle.
 3. Gradually add more pressure to shift slowly back to dark at the other side.
 4. Use shading to fill in and fix the edges.
