B. INCOME DATA COLLECTION FORM:

- 1. Forms will be mailed to all families mid-August. The Income Data Collection Form and information will also be available on the R-H website, https://www.rhnet.org and MealViewer
- 2. A new form must be submitted every year.
- 3. Last year's form expires 10/15/25.
- 4. A new form **must be** submitted by **10/3/25** for additional State & Federal Program benefits to continue.
- 5. It takes 10 days for forms to be approved, so get them in early.
- 6. Eligibility is determined by federal guidelines.
- 7. You will be notified in writing regarding your approval.
- 8. Some applications are verified for correct income information.
- 9. Call 359-5388 if you have any questions.

C. SNAP, TANF, DIRECT CERTIFICATION LETTER:

If you receive SNAP or TANF you will receive a Direct Certification Letter.

- 1. You must give the **original letter** to the Food Service Department or the cafeteria cashier. Social Services will **NOT** notify the school district.
- 2. This letter takes the place of the Income Data Form. Fill in your child's **SCHOOL AND GRADE**, and give the **original** letter to the cafeteria cashier.
- 3. If you lose your letter, Social Services will **NOT** replace it. You still need to fill out a form.

D. PREPAYING FOR SNACKS/EXTRA ENTREE:

This is a great way to avoid losing or forgetting money.

You can prepay by:

- 1. Sending a check payable to Rush-Henrietta Food Service Department, **OR**
- 2. Sending cash to school with your child, OR
- 3. You may use your credit card or e-check by calling 877-237-0946 or logging on to www.mypaymentsplus.com.

Information regarding meal payment is listed on the next page.

- 4. If you have more than one child **IN THE SAME SCHOOL**, you may send one check. Include the names and amounts for each child on the memo line of the check. The check can be made out to Rush-Henrietta Food Service. Please Note: Minimum check amount allowed is \$5.00.
- 5. If you have students in different schools, please send the check to Rush-Henrietta Food Service Office, 1133 Lehigh Station Rd., Henrietta, NY 14467. Include the names and amounts for each child on the memo line of the check.
- 6. If your check is returned for insufficient funds, or the account is closed, a \$20 check fee will be charged by the Food Service office and your checks will not be accepted in the future.

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7. Rush-Henrietta's Automated Prepayment System Information

- 1. To get started, simply visit www.mypaymentsplus.com or call 877-237-0946 and register your child. You will need your child's student ID number to register.
- 2. The convenience fee is 4.75% of your total transaction; if your total transaction is \$100 or more, this fee is waived.
- 3. You do not need to make a credit card transaction if you just want to check your child's balance or purchases.

Among the many benefits:

- Access the system around the clock.
- > Review your child's purchases.
- No more lost meal money.
- ➤ Low account balance e-mail notification.
- Money deposited in meal pay arrives in your child's account in a matter of minutes.

E. STUDENT ACCOUNTS:

- 1. All cafeteria cash registers are computerized.
- 2. I.D. number are needed for all purchases, breakfast, lunch, and a la cart.
- 3. I.D. cards are given to Grades UPK-3 students at meal times. All students have an account, which is accessed with their student I.D. # (I.D. card). Grades 4-12, students punch in their number on keypads.
- 4. The system provides complete confidentiality.

F. BREAKFAST: No Charge for Grades UPK-12

G. LUNCH MENU: No Charge for Grades UPK-12

Be sure to let the nurse-teacher know if your child has a food allergy.

Menus comply with federal regulations for the National Nutritional Meal Pattern.

- Entrée choices are:
 - Grades UPK-6: Daily Entrée, Sandwich of the Day, PBJ, and Build your own Yogurt Plate.
 - Hamburger on a Bun (Grades UPK-6) is offered on Monday, Wednesday & Friday.
 - Hot Grilled Chicken Sandwich (Grades UPK-6) is offered on Tuesday & Thursday.
 - Grades 7-12: Daily Entrée, Sandwich of the Day, Cheeseburger, Domino's Pizza, Veggie
 Burger, Grilled Chicken Salad Plates. Variety of Grab & Go Sandwiches and Salads (HS only)
- Grades UPK-6: Daily side dish choices include: Assorted fresh fruits, tossed salad, daily vegetables and dished fruits.
 - 100% fruit juice offered only on Tuesdays & Thursdays.
- Grades 7-12: Daily side dish choices include: 100% fruit juice, assorted fresh fruits, tossed salad, daily vegetables and dished fruits.
- All Grades: Students must take a ½ cup of Fruit or Vegetable at Lunch to be a Complete Meal
- Meals are completed with milk choice of 1% white, fat free white or fat free chocolate milk.
- Those who bring a meal from home may purchase condiments, plastic ware package, napkins, straws, etc. These items are included with a purchased meal.
