**Name of the Skill:** Be Respectful at special events

**BE RESPECTFUL**

## Special Events

- \*Follow adult directions
- \*Be mindful of your and others' space.
- \*Stay quiet

### Purpose of the Lesson/Why is it important:

1. To establish a positive, safe and caring learning environment.
2. To practice what a positive, safe and caring learning environment looks like at special events.
3. To ensure that others around you can see, hear and enjoy the special event.

### Teaching Scenarios:

1. Your teacher asks you to sit on the floor for the assembly. You find a spot and sit down quietly.
2. Before you sit down, you check to make sure that you and your neighbors have enough personal space.
3. During the special event, you keep your mouth quiet and your body in its personal bubble.
4. While you are waiting for the special event to start, you are taking quietly with your friends around you, when the signal is given; you stop talking and look to the speaker.

### Student Activities/ Role Plays

Discuss/Model/Practice:

1. Following directions.
2. Finding and maintaining your personal bubble.
3. Staying quiet.

### Follow Up/Reinforcement Activities:

1. Teacher compliments the class.
2. Ask students to report others who follow the rules.
3. Staff increases rewards (STARS and tokens).
4. Pre-correct expected behaviors (Reminders before behaviors are expected).
