School wide Expectation: Be Respectful

Name of the Skill: Be Respectful in bathrooms

Purpose of the Lesson/Why is it important:

- 1. To establish and maintain a clean, safe, and private environment.
- 2. To practice what clean, safe, and private behavior looks like in the bathrooms.

Teaching Scenarios:

- 1. You are on the way to the bathroom and see a friend that wants to talk about a movie. You remember that your teacher told you to go and come right back from the bathroom. You tell your friend that you will call him at home and go directly to the bathroom and then return to class.
- 2. You need to wash your hands and there is another student at the sink. You remember to keep your personal space and wait until the other student leaves the sink to wash your hands.
- 3. You are in the bathroom and need to use the toilet. The door is closed. You knock lightly and listen for a response. Another student says, "I am in here." You wait patiently away from the stalls. After the student walks past you, you enter the stall.

Student Activities/ Role Plays

Discuss/Model/Practice:

- 1. Following directions.
- 2. Being mindful of your and others' space
- 3. Giving people privacy

Follow Up/Reinforcement Activities:

- 1. Teacher compliments the student.
- 2. Ask students to report others who follow the rules.
- 3. Staff increases rewards (STARS and tokens).
- 4. Pre-correct expected behaviors (Reminders before behaviors are expected).
