Dear Parents,

Mother's Day is an annual holiday to recognize and honor mothers and motherhood. Although the holiday itself is held on various days in many parts of the world, here in the United States we celebrate it on the second Sunday of May.



Here's a brief history of how the modern version of Mother's Day came to be:

In 1907, Anna Jarvis from Philadelphia began a campaign to establish a national Mother's Day. She persuaded her mother's church in Grafton, West Virginia, to hold a memorial on May 10, 1908—three years after her mother's death. Jarvis had five hundred white carnations (her mother's favorite flower) delivered to Andrews Methodist Episcopal Church, now a U.S. National Historic Landmark. That same afternoon, 15,000 people attended a Mother's Day service in Philadelphia, which Jarvis also organized.

Afterward, Jarvis and her supporters wrote to ministers, business people, and politicians in a quest to establish a national Mother's Day. They succeeded, and by 1911 the holiday was celebrated in almost every state. In 1914, President Woodrow Wilson proclaimed Mother's Day a national holiday, with flags flown "on the second Sunday in May as a public expression of our love and reverence for the mothers of our country."

I wish all of the mothers an especially healthy, safe, and *Happy Mother's Day!*

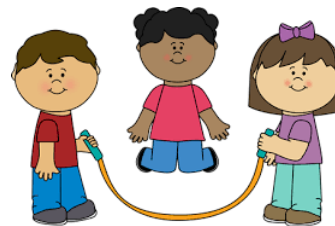
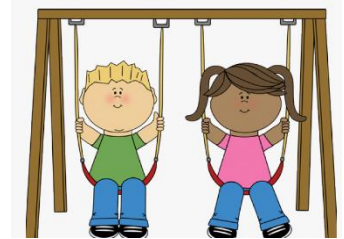
May is National Physical Fitness & Sports Month
