Prior Board Approval

April 2022 – Board of Education endorsed \$18.2M project

- Secondary Auditorium sound and lighting upgrades
- High School Natatorium renovation
- Leary renovations and parking lot expansion
- Other miscellaneous building renovations
- Good Shepherd building cosmetic renovations

Summer 2022 – facilities security audit conducted

- Many maintenance updates such as locks, window covering, etc.
- High School secure vestibule
- Districtwide fobs and contact sensors on all exterior doors

Good Shepherd Site

- BOE renewed Webster Bldg. lease for three years rather than five
- Expedited transition of UPK and community programs to Webster Bldg.







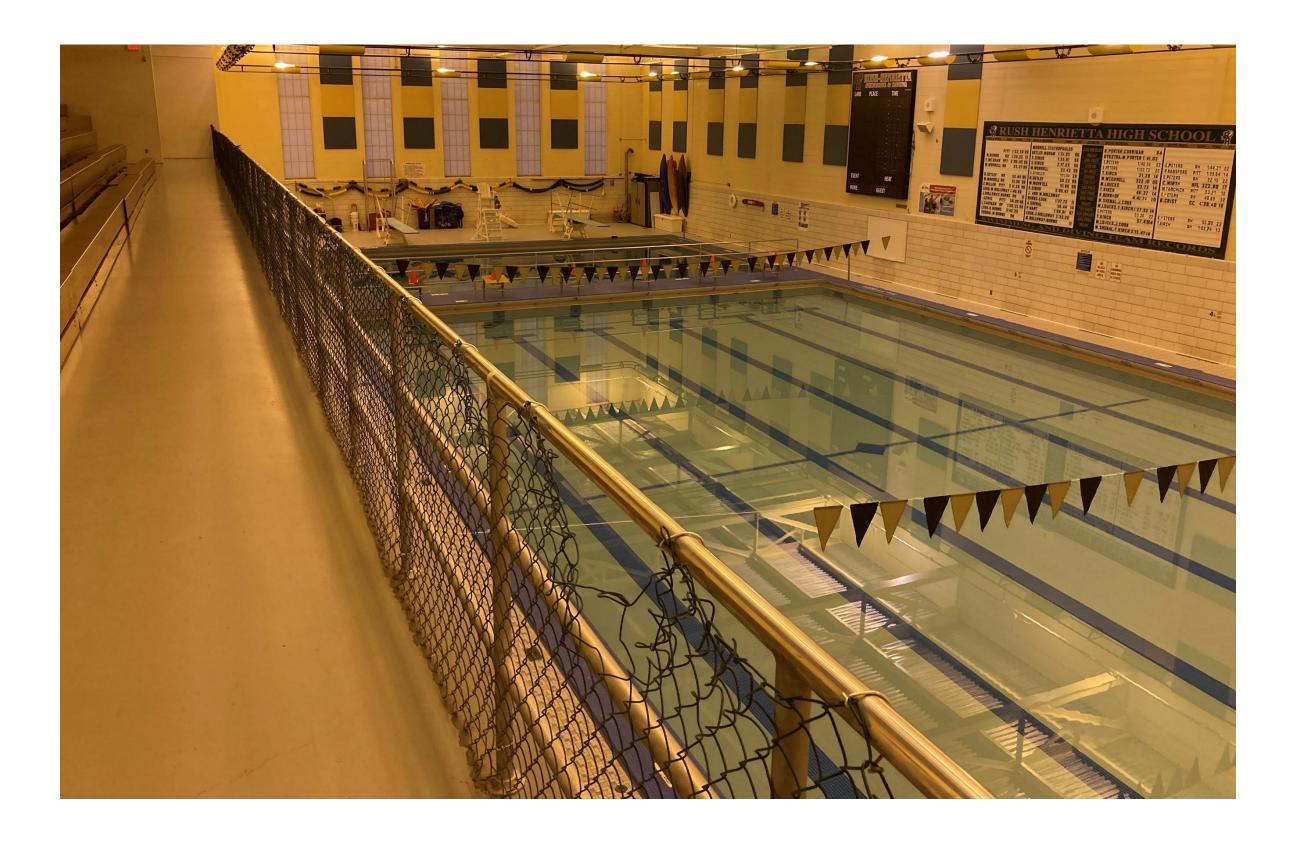

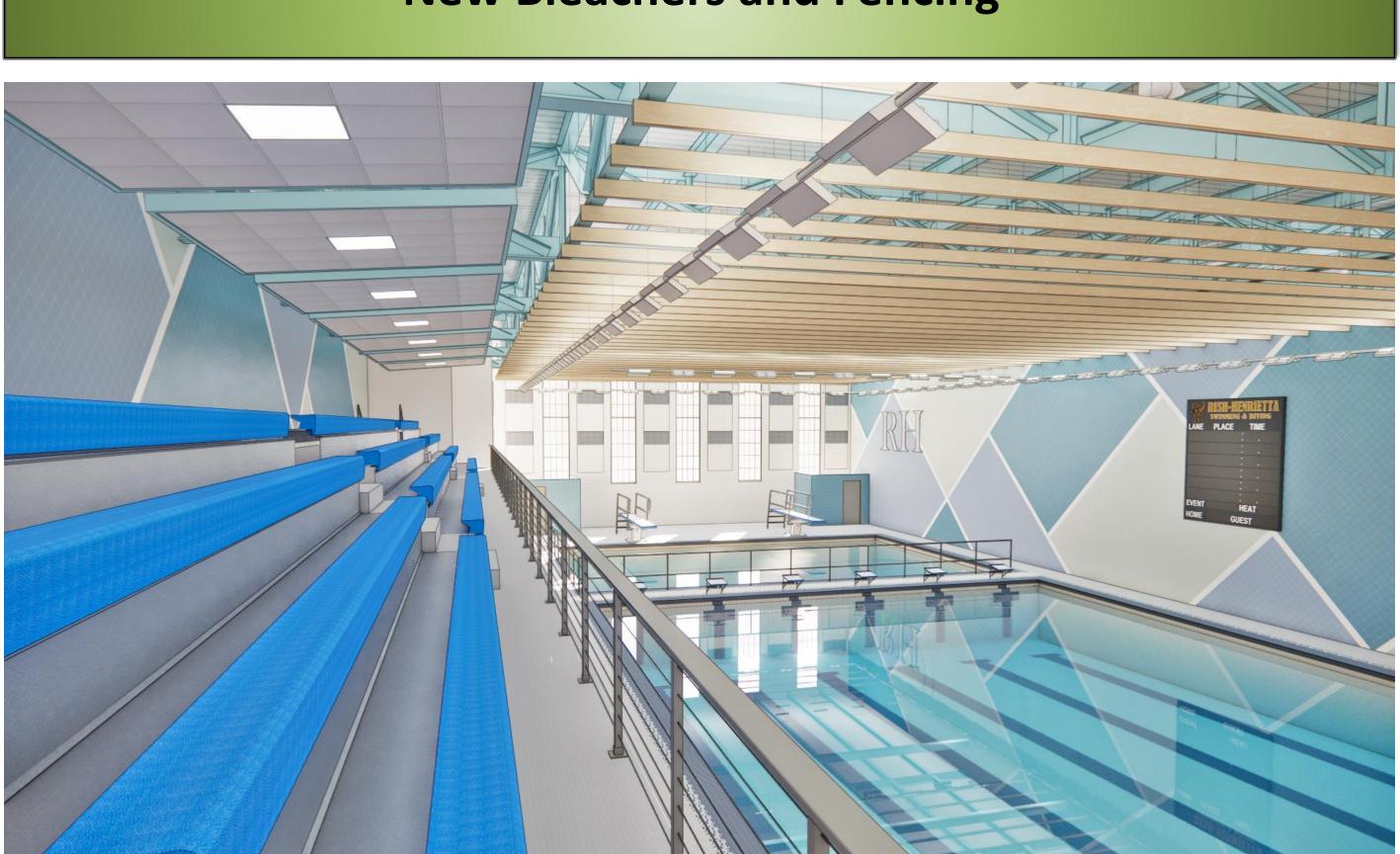


Current Spectator Fencing



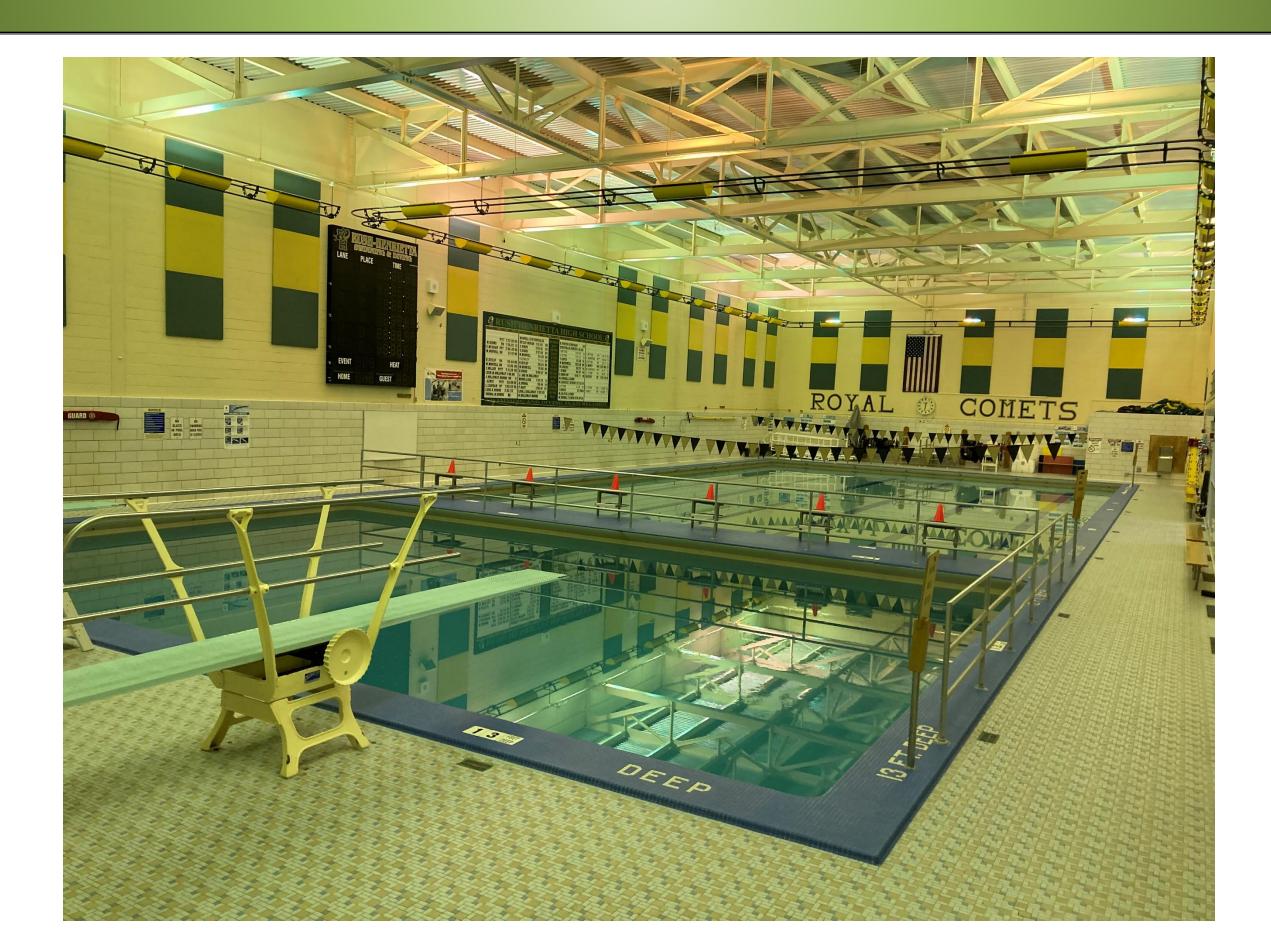


New Bleachers and Fencing



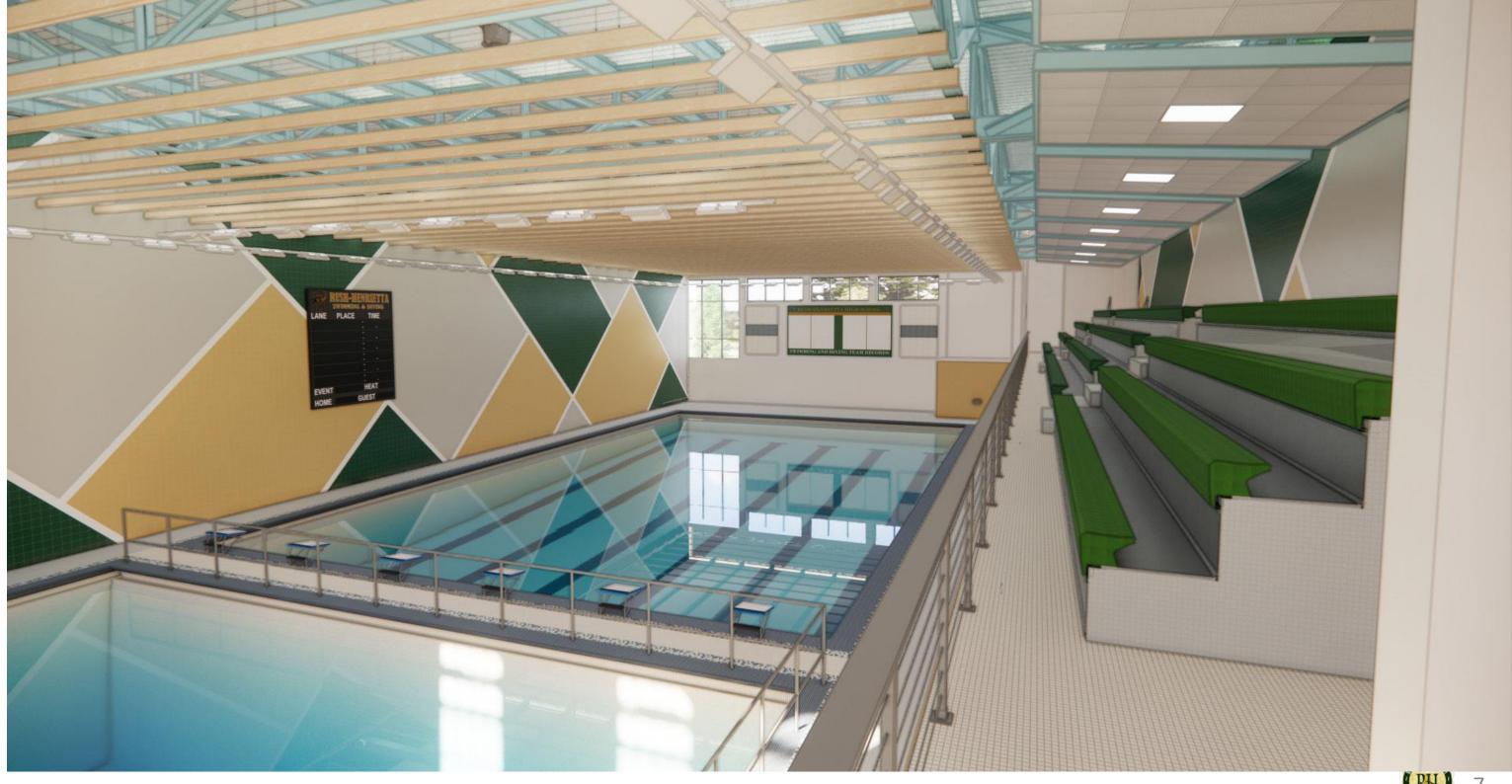


Current Pool Area

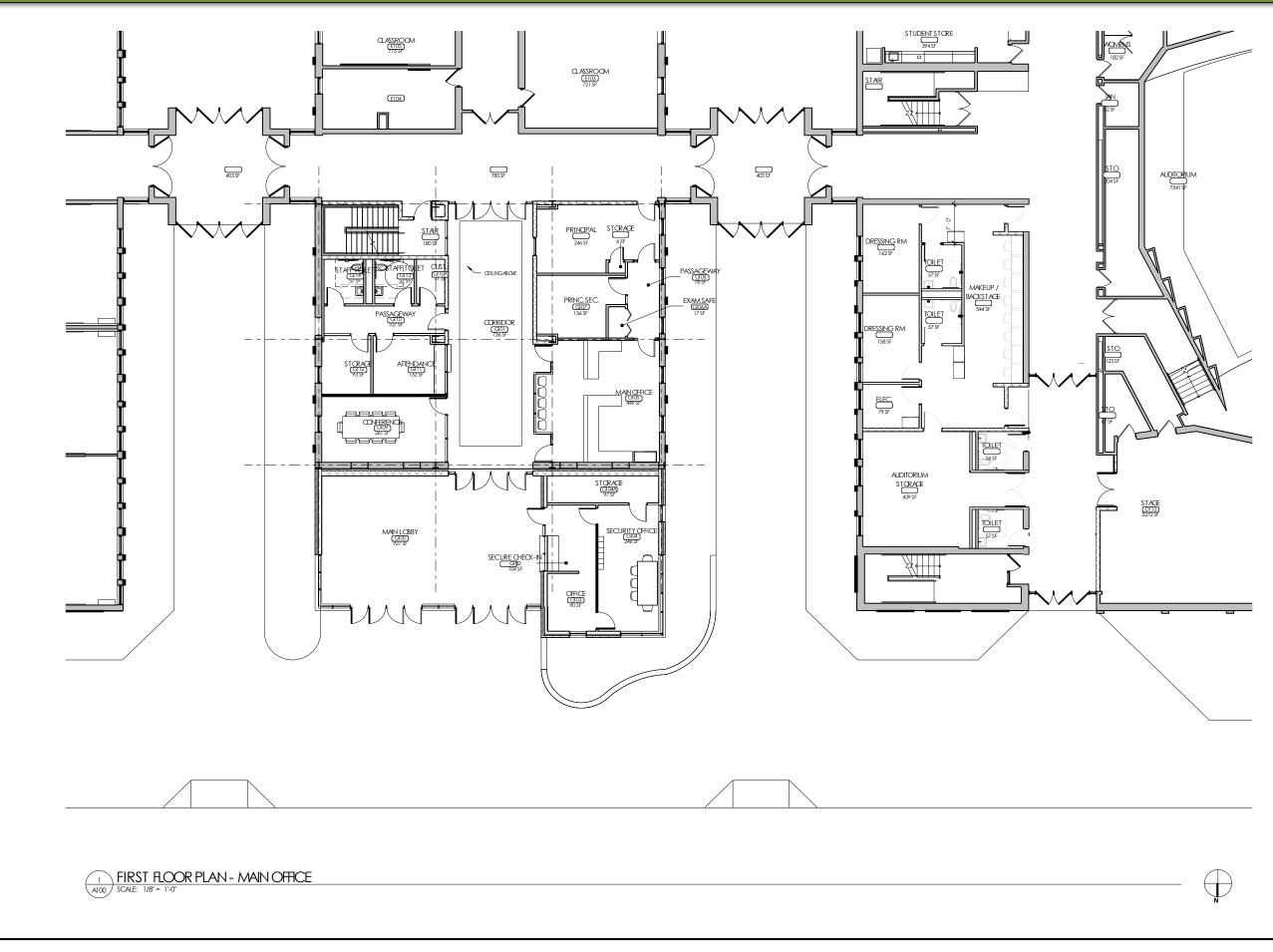

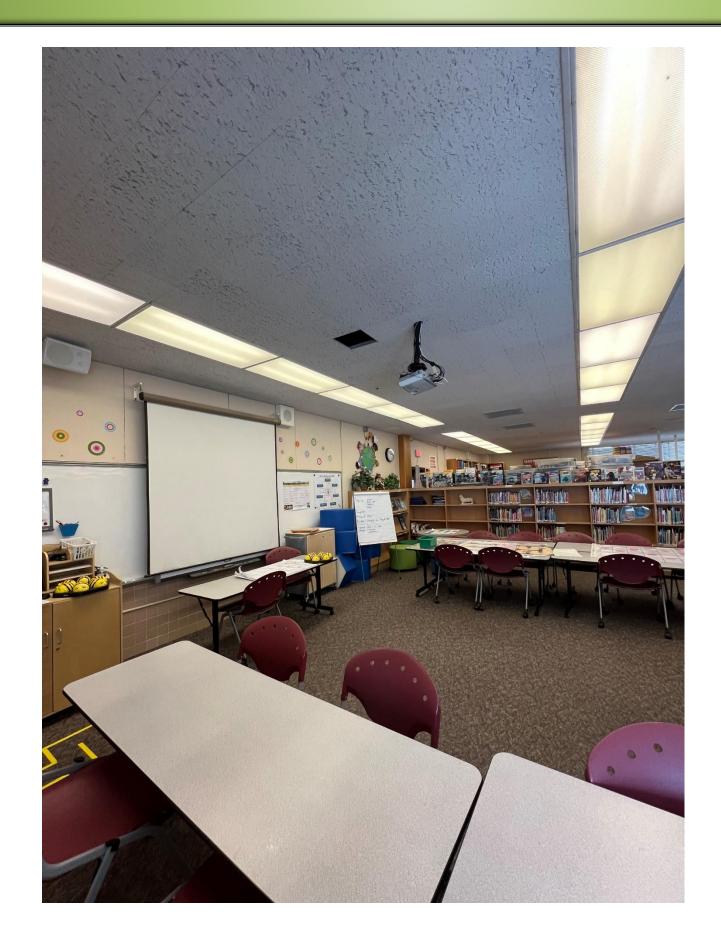

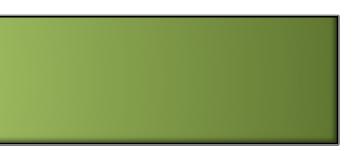






Leary Library (Current)

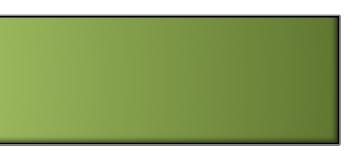






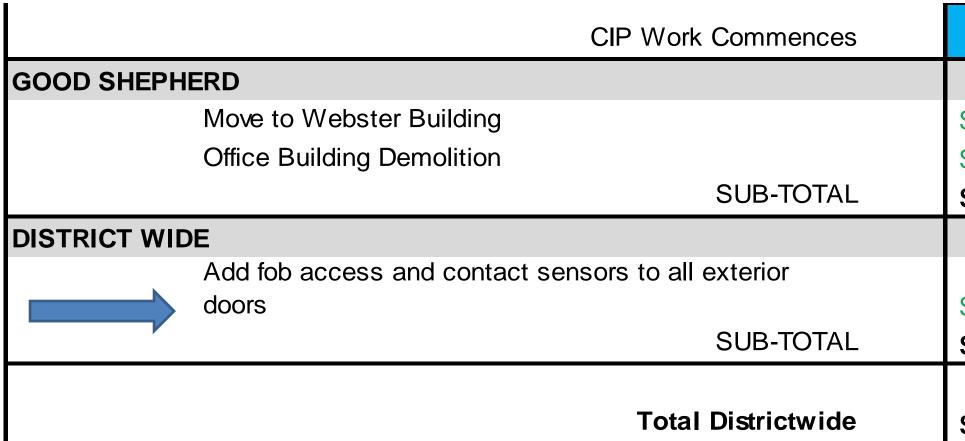
