– Engaging Students in learning

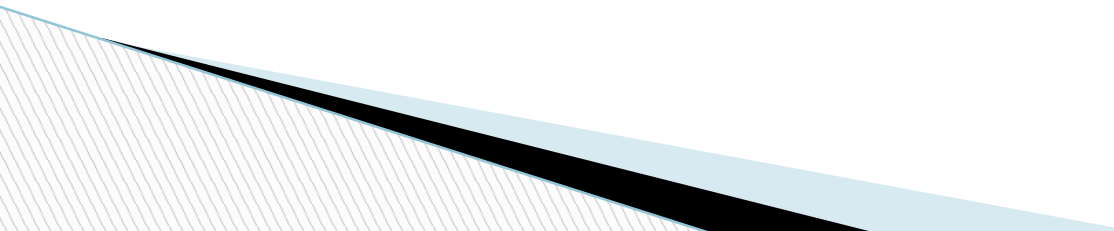
- ❑ activities require high-level student thinking and explanations of their thinking
- ❑ students have opportunity for reflection and closure on the lesson
- ❑ Pacing of lesson allows students to do the above
- ❑ Variety of grouping/independent work patterns

❑ Using Assessment in Instruction

- ❑ Teacher constantly takes the “pulse” of the class throughout lesson
- ❑ Students monitor their own understanding, set goals on their own or as a task set by the teacher
- ❑ High quality feedback comes from many sources – including students
- ❑ Feedback is specific and focused on improvement




Student Character


