




Find the Volume of the Half-Sphere and Cylinder combination *in terms of π*





Volume of Composite Figures

- Find the Volume of the Half-Sphere and Cylinder combination *in terms of π*



$$V = \frac{4}{3} \cdot \pi \cdot r^3$$

$$r = 4 \text{ m} \quad V = \frac{4}{3} \cdot \pi \cdot 4^3$$

$$V = 85.3\pi \quad \div 2$$

$$V_{\frac{1}{2}SPH} = 42.6\pi \text{ m}^3$$

$$V = \pi \cdot r^2 \cdot h$$

$$V = \pi \cdot 4^2 \cdot 12$$

$$V = 192\pi \text{ m}^3$$

Total Volume

$$234.6\pi \text{ m}^3$$

- Find the Volume of the Cone and Rectangular Prism *to the nearest tenth of a cubic meter*


$$r = 4.5 \text{ m}$$

$$h = 10 \text{ m}$$

Cone

$$V = \frac{1}{3} \cdot \pi \cdot r^2 \cdot h$$

$$V = \frac{1}{3} \cdot \pi \cdot (4.5)^2 \cdot 10$$



$$V = L \times W \times H$$

$$V = 17 \cdot 9 \cdot 5$$

$$V = 212.1 \text{ m}^3$$

$$V = 765 \text{ m}^3$$

Total Volume:

$$977.1 \text{ m}^3$$
